HOW THIS WORKS:

This is easy peasy lemon-squeezy.

First, you'll be sent an email with your membership login and password. From here you will be able to access the "members only" area of the website where you will find resources, interventions, songs, visuals, videos, and all material ever created in Creative Therapy Umbrella.

Then, you will then receive access to the private Facebook group for community members only. This is a safe space for us to come together as clinicians and share ideas, learn from each other, and have fun!

You will be sent a zoom link for every 50-minute group consultation call directly to your email. These links will also be provided in the private Facebook group.

In order to receive the 15 CBMT credits, you will have to attend and/or watch the recorded group consultation calls (15 total). At the end of the year, you will get an e-mail with links to the evaluation and the post-test. Once you pass the post-test, you will be sent a pre-approved CBMT certificate!

Throughout the year, I will open up additional office hours for 30-minute private consultation calls to support you with your direct and individualized needs as a clinician.

COMMUNITY COURSE INFORMATION

Prerequisites:

None. This community course is designed for all levels of therapists, including students, interns, entry-level professionals and seasoned professionals looking to learn more about child developmental and mental health.

Objectives:

- Participants will identify humanistic approaches and how they can be integrated into music therapy for children. (CBMT Domain III.A.3.e)
- Participants will identify five creative and flexible responses to clients behaviors, verbalizations, or actions. (CBMT Domain III.A.5.ee)
- Participants will identify five ways to bring in individualized preferences of a client to support musical and/or creative engagement. (CBMT Domain III.A.2.ff)
- Participants will identify five books/articles/research that supports the use of various approaches as it applies to support child mental health and wellness.(CBMT V.A.2.)

Number of Credits:

This community course is available for 15 credits through CBMT. Partial credit cannot be offered. The 15 credits will be offered at the end of the year cycle once all group consultation calls have been recorded and completed.

Materials:

Access to membership site that includes: songs, video tutorials, visuals, intervention ideas, and Informational downloads. Access to a private Facebook group for members only. Recorded versions of group consultation calls available on Facebook group.

Opportunity Cost:
