# Make it Multisensory!



Welcome to the course, "Make it Multisensory: combining music, movement and visuals to increase engagement and enhance learning."

In this course we will explore ways in which the combination of music, visuals, and movement can not only enhance attention and participation, but can also

**spark endless ideas for creating interventions that target developmental goals.**

Throughout the course we'll be touching on a variety of ways to enhance engagement and learning by increasing multisensory experiences such as:

Increasing the use of visuals in your sessions to build literacy skills, increase comprehension, build expressive and receptive language skills, and enhance engagement.

Adding props to add a tactile component to explore.

Including specific movements in our interventions that activate and organizing the brain, and including specific movements that help regulate the body and provide calming sensory input.

# Who Is This Course For?

This course is created both for those just beginning their career as a music therapist, as well as those looking to spark new ideas for multisensory interventions.

We are passionate about this topic first and foremost because it enhances learning opportunities for the children we support. Secondly, and also very important, we feel it prevents burnout. Music therapists are constantly creating new material to support the needs of their clients. We found that as soon as we began adding visuals, props and movements to our interventions, the intervention ideas became limitless. For us, this was a huge weight lifted and we hope it will be for you as well.

## The Course

This course is set up as two music therapy sessions. With each intervention, we'll share the "what and why" of the elements we've combined (auditory, visual, tactile) to draw children in and create a rich learning environment.

This course includes 14 ready-to-use interventions to jumpstart (or add to) your multisensory intervention collection and inspire the creation of new material to bring to the children you support.
